The public has until close of business on 14 January 2008 to lodge a submission on the proposed Traveston Crossing Dam.

This dam will destroy the habitat of internationally listed species and reduce flows to the Great Sandy Strait wetlands. Yet water supply alternatives to the dam are inadequately addressed in the Environmental Impact Statement; and the EIS inadequately addresses climate change impacts which impinge upon reliability of water yield from the dam.
