You are invited to comment on the Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed development at Shute Harbour – comments due Monday 15th December

Shute Harbour Marina Development Pty Ltd proposes to construct an integrated marina, resort hotel and residential community at Shute Harbour. The site is located within the Whitsunday Shire Council local government area at Shute Harbour Road, Shute Harbour. This site has been subject to investigations for a previously declared significant project that did not proceed.

Environmental Impact Statement process

On 24 July 2006 the Coordinator-General declared Shute Harbour Marina Project a 'significant project' for which an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required in accordance with Part 4 of the *State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971* (Qld).

The Federal Minister for the Department of Environment and Heritage decided, on 27 July 2006, that the project is a 'controlled action' and subject to assessment under Section 75 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (Cth).
