Relocation of Spectacled Flying-foxes at Port Douglas – comments due Wednesday 13 June 2007  
Reef Cove Resort development at False Cape – comments due Monday 18 June 2007

### **Relocation of Spectacled Flying-foxes at Port Douglas – comments due 13 June 2007**

Anthony Buckley, Natural Resources Management, proposes to relocate of a colony of Spectacled Flying-foxes bats from a residential and resort area in Port Douglas (*Ref no.* 2007/3473). Qld Parks and Wildlife have recommended three methods for the relocation. Fogging, water spray and bird shot, all will be used simultaneously over a period of one to two weeks. The bats are currently in Undine St, Opal St, Agincourt St and Jewel Close Port Douglas. Bale Port Douglas Site - Lot 109 Port Douglas Rd port Douglas. Potential controlling provisions include ss 18 & 18A (threatened species or threatened ecological communities). Comments due by **13 June 2007**. ### **Reef Cove Resort development at False Cape – comments due 18 June 2007**

The action is the final stage of the Starline Australia Holdings Reef Cove Resort (tourism and recreation) development at False Cape, Cairns (*Ref no.* 2007/3482). The total area of the subject site is 120.5ha. The first stage involved 123 residential lots, hotel, townhouses, resort village and service infrastructure over a total area of 34.7ha (EPBC ref. 2003/1179). The current action involves construction of 15 residential lots, 10 duplex villas and service infrastructure over a total area of 5.9ha. Potential controlling provisions include ss 18 & 18A (threatened species or threatened ecological communities); and ss 20 & 20A (migratory species). Comments due by **18 June 2007**.
