Proposal for the replacement of the 132kV transmission lines between Ingham and Tully with a new 275/132kV dual voltage transmission line. The easement required by the new transmission line is planned to be approximately 95km long and up to 60m wide, covering an area of approximately 570ha. The corridor traverses several sections of the Wet Tropics Area with 32 listed threatened species within the study area. The study area is also adjacent to the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Area and there are 33 migratory species listed, including marine mammals, birds and a shark.

The referral considers that the proposed action is unlikely to have a significant impact on the matters of National Environmental Significance stating that mitigation plans and limited clearing of vegetation. Full details are available by clicking on the link above.
